### RED LIGHT CAMERA SAFETY PROGRAM

#### Public Announcement

**April 30, 2010**

As part of its public awareness campaign, the Town of Haverhill has implemented an intersection safety program which uses automated cameras to enforce the Town of Haverhill's **"Dangerous Intersection Safety Act" Ordinance**. These cameras record when vehicles run a red light in the Town. The camera records the image of the motor vehicle and license plate as well as the intersection and traffic control device at the intersection.

The cameras are located at the intersection of Belvedere and Haverhill Roads and have been operational since April 15, 2010. Additional cameras are contemplated for the intersection of Military Trail and Belvedere Road. Any infraction of the Ordinance occurring April 15, 2010 through May 31, 2010 shall be issued a **Courtesy Warning Notice** depicting the vehicle running a red light.

Upon expiration of the warning period, any violation captured by red light cameras within the Town shall be issued a **Notice of Infraction** which may result in a fine being imposed.

The Ordinance, in its entirety, is available for inspection and copying at the Town Hall between the hours of 9 a.m. and 5 p.m., Monday through Friday, except legal holidays. If you have any questions regarding the Ordinance, cameras, or program, please call the Town at 689-0370.
