- Thursday, September 22, 2011 7:00 p.m. Adoption of ordinances

All interested parties are invited to attend and be heard with respect to the proposed Ordinance.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE AND BE ADVISED that if any interested person desires to appeal any decision made by the Town Council with respect to any matter considered at such meeting or hearing, such person will need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made, which record includes the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based. The Town does not prepare or provide such a record. The following ordinances, or any one of them, may be postponed or withdrawn without prior notice.

ORDINANCE NO. 400

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF HAVERHILL, FLORIDA, AMENDING CHAPTER 58, ZONING, BY AMENDING SECTION 58-8 BY DELETING REFERENCE TO "CHURCH" IN THE DEFINITIONS AND SUBSTITUTING IN ITS PLACE "PLACE OF WORSHIP"; AMENDING SECTIONS 58-184 AND 58-199 TO ALLOW PLACES OF WORSHIP AS A SPECIAL EXCEPTION IN THE R-2 AND R-3 RESIDENTIAL ZONING DISTRICTS OF THE TOWN, AND BY CREATING A NEW DIVISION 13 IN ARTICLE IX, SUPPLEMENTAL DISTRICT REGULATIONS, BY SETTING FORTH THE REGULATIONS FOR PLACES OF WORSHIP INCLUDING THE MAXIMUM LOT COVERAGE, FRONTAGE REQUIREMENTS, PARKING REGULATIONS, CLASSIFICATION FOR PURPOSES OF BUFFER, SEASONAL USE RESTRICTIONS AND OTHER SUCH REGULATIONS; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF LAWS IN CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND CODIFICATION, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF HAVERHILL, FLORIDA, AMENDING CHAPTER 22, OFFENSES, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES FOR THE TOWN OF HAVERHILL BY REPEALING SECTION 22-2, DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS PROHIBITED; EXEMPTION; AND ANY OTHER PROVISION OF THE TOWN CODE REGULATING OR ATTEMPTING TO REGULATE THE PURCHASE, SALE, TRANSFER, TAXATION, MANUFACTURE, OWNERSHIP, POSSESSION, STORAGE, AND TRANSPORTATION OF FIREARMS OR AMMUNITION; PROVIDING A CONFLICTS CLAUSE, AUTHORITY TO CODIFY; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

ORDINANCE NO. 402

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF HAVERHILL, FLORIDA, DESIGNATING AN OFFICIAL SEAL OF THE TOWN OF HAVERHILL PURSUANT TO SECTION 165.043, FLORIDA STATUTES, AND PROHIBITING THE MANUFACTURE, USE, DISPLAY, OR OTHER EMPLOYMENT OF ANY FACSIMILE OR REPRODUCTION OF THE TOWN SEAL EXCEPT BY THE TOWN OFFICIALS, AGENTS OR EMPLOYEES IN THE PERFORMANCE OF THEIR OFFICIAL DUTIES OR CONTRACTUAL RESPONSIBILITIES, WITHOUT THE EXPRESS APPROVAL OF THE TOWN COUNCIL; PROVIDING A CONFLICTS CLAUSE, AUTHORITY TO CODIFY; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

ORDINANCE NO. 404

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF HAVERHILL, FLORIDA, AMENDING CHAPTER 30, SOLID WASTE, BY AMENDING SECTION 30-1, DEFINITIONS, AND SECTIONS 30-41, 30-61 AND 30-86 REGARDING THE PROVISION THAT MULTIFAMILY RESIDENTIAL STRUCTURES IN EXCESS OF FOUR (4) UNITS WILL BE REQUIRED TO ARRANGE FOR THEIR OWN SOLID WASTE COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF LAWS IN CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR AUTHORITY TO CODIFY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.
