



# School District of Palm Beach County Voluntary Prekindergarten (VPK)



## 2026-2027 Enrollment Guidelines

*Enroll your 4-year-old in an elementary school that offers a high-quality VPK program taught by certified teachers and credentialed assistants!*

- WHO:** Children who turn four (4) years of age on or before September 1, 2026, and have a VPK Certificate are eligible for the 2026-2027 school year. Children who turn four (4) between February 2 and September 1, 2026, may attend during 2026-2027 or may wait a year to attend during the 2027-2028 school year.
- WHAT:** The Florida VPK program is voluntary and prepares 4-year-old children for success in kindergarten and beyond. Parents may choose the free 540-hour School Year VPK program or the 300-hour Summer VPK program, but not both.
- WHEN:** All VPK programs follow the District's school year calendar and classes start on August 10, 2026.
- WHERE :** The VPK program will be offered at select (not all) public school sites. The list of school sites with [VPK programs can be found here](#) or on the back of this flyer.
- HOW:**
- Step 1: Obtain a VPK Certificate Online.** Starting January 1, 2026, obtain a VPK Certificate online at [www.elcpalmbeach.org](http://www.elcpalmbeach.org); for help call the Early Learning Coalition at (561) 514-3300.
  - Step 2: Find Your School & Determine Options.** Starting in mid-January, view the District's website [www.palmbeachschools.org/prek](http://www.palmbeachschools.org/prek) for a list of participating District schools.
  - Step 3: Visit the School In Person to Apply for a VPK Seat.**
  - Step 4: Notification of Selection.** Families will be notified by the school of their child's selection status. Children not selected will go on a waitlist in order of application.
