# TOWN OF HAVERHILL MINUTES SPECIAL MAGISTRATE HEARING MARCH 6, 2024

Present: Special Magistrate William P. Doney, Code Enforcement Officer Joseph Petrick, Town Attorney John Foster, Town Administrator Tracey Stevens, Deputy Town Clerk Jean Wible.

# I. CALL TO ORDER:

The meeting was called to order at 9:00 A.M. by Special Magistrate William P. Doney.

# II. SWEARING IN OF WITNESSESS:

Special Magistrate Doney administered Oath to Code Enforcement Officer Joseph Petrick and Deputy Town Clerk Jean Wible.

# **CODE ENFORCEMENT VIOLATION HEARING:**

CASE NO. 24-00007 MARTINEZ CLARIBEL 5465 STRATFORD RD HAVERHILL, FL 33415

NATURE OF VIOLATION: Chapter 14 Section 14-2 Permit and Inspection fees for building, electricity, and plumbing Chapter 14 Section 14-7 Unsafe buildings and structures

Code Enforcement Officer (CEO) Joseph Petrick testified that this case was in reference to a Single-Family residence in violation of Town Code Sections 14-2 and 14-7 for an expired above ground pool permit. He stated the pool permit was applied for on May 1, 2023, issued on May 23, 2023, and expired on October 30, 2023. He stated that on January 24, 2024, Deputy Town Clerk Jean Wible notified him of the expired permit and explained that she had not had any response from the several telephone calls, texts or emails made to the Respondent, Claribel Martinez between October 30, 2023, and January 10, 2024. On January 25, 2024, CEO Petrick issued a Notice of Violation and Notice of Hearing via certified mail to the address listed on the Property Appraisers

website, property was posted, and posted on the Code Enforcement board at Town Hall. The Notice of Violation and Notice of Hearing gave the Respondent thirty days (30) days to comply by obtaining a final inspection for the pool or by removing the pool if installed. He testified that the Respondent had not responded as of today's hearing to the Notices sent.

CEO Petrick provided copies of the issued permit, emails, and notes from Deputy Town Clerk Wible.

CEO Petrick stated the Town was requesting compliance within thirty days (30) days or a \$100.00 per day fine be assessed.

It is the Order of the Special Magistrate that Respondent shall comply with Code Sections 14-2 and 14-7 of the Town's Code of Ordinance by April 5, 2024. In the event Respondent does not comply within the time period specified above, a fine in the amount of One Hundred (\$100.00) dollars per day may be imposed for each day the violation(s) continues to exist.

A Fine Assessment Hearing, if necessary, shall be held before the Special Magistrate on May 1, 2024, at 9:00 a.m. at Town Hall to determine whether Respondent has complied with the terms and conditions of this Order and to consider the assessment of a fine.

<u>NATURE OF VIOLATION:</u> Chapter 14 Section 14-2 Permit and Inspection fees for building, electricity, and plumbing Chapter 14 Section 14-7 Unsafe buildings and structures

Code Enforcement Officer (CEO) Joseph Petrick stated that both the Town and the Respondents were requesting a continuance until the May 1, 2024, hearing as the Respondent had requested to go before Town Council to request a variation of Town Code for the driveway.
