Mayor

Mayor Foy reminded all about the need to schedule a Code and Ordinance Committee meeting.

Mayor Foy had requested an inventory of streetlights that had been reported out and not yet repaired throughout the Town. Joseph Roche, Director of Public Services reported that of the 113 street lights in the Town, there were only three lights remaining out.

Town Administrator

The Town Administrator reported on the request of Schmidt Nichols for a letter of support from the Town in response to a development order amendment for the Duke property on the northwest corner of Belvedere and Jog Roads to allow for a reduction in the side yard interior building setback and to allow for outdoor storage.

Discussion followed regarding the many applications for development orders coming before the County and it was the general consensus that the Town would continue to send letters of objection citing the Town Council's concern that the County's continued approval of amendments to pending projects along Belvedere, Haverhill Road, Jog Road, Southern Boulevard and Okeechobee Boulevard will result in increased traffic along Haverhill and Belvedere Roads within the Town's jurisdiction.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

Joseph Roche, Director of Public Services reported on the Park and Cyprus Lane Drainage Improvement project.

He updated Council on the structure that had been placed on the west side of Park Lane with a 60'-80' pipe that would continue to the Town's boundary as there was concern about the location of the gas line.

The swale grass will be installed manually. It was estimated the project was six weeks from finish.

NEW BUSINESS

Palm Beach County would be milling and overlaying Haverhill Road from Summit to north of Belvedere beginning February 12, 2018.

Mr. Roche reported that town wide street sweeping had taken place.

The Town Administrator had reported that PBSO had set up traffic control on Belvedere Road and 60-80 tickets had been issued during the 2 shifts they were present. Discussion followed as to speeding on Belvedere Road and the need for enforcement.
